Town Ordinance

Ordinance # 01 — 2012

The Board of Selectmen of the Town of Salisbury hereby enact the following ordinance for the regulation of Hawkers, Peddlers and Itinerant Vendors:

1 . LICENSE REQUIRED

No person or persons shall sell goods or merchandise within the Town of Salisbury as a Hawker, Peddler or Itinerant Vendor unless they first obtain a license to do so. Licenses issued under this ordinance shall be subject to the procedures, regulations and guidelines established by the Salisbury Board of Selectmen, to whom such authority is herewith delegated.

2. DEFINITIONS

As used in this ordinance, the following terms shall be the definitions indicated; HAWKER and PEDDLER- shall mean and include any person, either principal or agent who travels from town to town, or from place to place in the same town, selling or bartering or carrying for sale or barter or exposing therefor any goods, wares, or merchandise, either on foot or from any animal, cart, or vehicle; or any person who travels from town to town, or place to place in the same town, offering to perform personal services for household repairs and improvements, or solicits or induces any person to sign any contracts relating to household repairs and improvements.

ITINERANT VENDOR - shall mean all persons, both principals and agents, including those persons whose principal place of business is not in the state, who engages in temporary or transient business in the state, either in one locality or traveling from place to place, and who, for the purpose of carrying on such business, hires or occupies a temporary place of business. A "temporary place of business" means any public or quasipublic place, including, but not limited to, store room, building, part of a building, tent, vacant lot, railroad car or trailer, temporarily occupied for the purpose of making retail sales of goods to the public.

3. APPLICATION

- a. Complete and submit an application, including a \$125.00 dollar processing fee. Application must include full legal name (licensee & vendors), home address and phone number, local address, goods to be sold, location of goods, exact times & locations of when vending will take place and vehicle identification information.
- 4. HOURS OF OPERATION: Only during daylight hours; specifically one half hour after dawn and one half hour before dusk.
- 5. SALES ON PUBLIC PROPERTY: No Licensees shall advertise or place signs for goods for sale on any sidewalk, street, right-of-way or property owned by the Town of Salisbury unless written approval has been obtained from the Salisbury Board of Selectmen under the town's Zoning Ordinance's Article VIII. Licensees are reminded that they are only allowed on private property by permission of the owner; and they are otherwise subject to the laws of trespass.

6. EXEMPTIONS:

- a. Solicitations or fundraising efforts on behalf of any non-profit group based within the Town of Salisbury. The Board of Selectmen also reserves right to make further exemptions for other non-profit groups not based within the Town of Salisbury.
- b. Any persons selling products of his or her own labor or the labor of his or her family which are products as the result of farming. c. Any non-profit corporation, religious or charitable organization, foundation or educational institution when no part of the entity's earnings benefit any private shareholder or individual.
- d. Any person who sells exclusively antiques, used goods or vintage items.
- 7. FINES: Any Hawker, Peddler or Itinerant Vendor who violates the provisions of the Ordinance shall be fined a sum not to exceed \$10.00 per day for each day of such violation.
- 8. REVOCATION OF LICENSE: In addition to any penalty imposed, such license may be revoked for any violation of this ordinance.

TOWN OF SALISBURY, NEW HAMPSHIRE APPLICATION FOR HAWKER & PEDDLER'S LICENSE

No Hawker or Peddler shall conduct business in the Town of Salisbury at times other than one half hour after dawn and one half hour before dusk Monday through Saturday unless the Selectmen deem hours to be unreasonable.

Any Hawker or Peddler who violates the provisions of the Ordinance shall be fined a sum not to exceed \$10.00 per day for each day of such violation.

Any portion of the annual license fee may be waived at the discretion of the Selectmen for hawkers or peddlers who are domiciled in the Town of Salisbury.
