Open Meeting

Chairman Ross-Raymond called meeting to order at 5:30 PM.

 - Selectman Ballou moved to accept summary as written, Selectman Tucker seconded. All voted in favor.
- o Review Accounts Payable & Payroll registers. Select board moved and accepted.

Department Updates/Issues:

Road Agent MacDuffie

- Worked on Bay Rd and Salisbury Rd area where repaying will be done.
- Stop sign at Oak Hill Rd has been replaced
- Selectman Ross-Raymond asked when the Old Coach Road Project will be started.
 MacDuffie indicated it has not been scheduled yet. Sandy Miller asked if the by-pass between
 Old Coach Road and Rabbit Road is part of the project. MacDuffie replied yes it will be
 paved. Miller wonders if that section is needed. Selectmen replied that Rabbit Rd Ext. is used
 frequently by many including school buses.
- MacDuffie had a question regarding checklists and changing ones party noting he has seen recently about having to change party before next election. AA Downes explained it is mandated by RSA that any change in party status much be accomplished by a specific date before the upcoming primary. The date changes must be made for primary in September was May 31st. No registered voters may now change party affiliation now until after the primary election.

Library Trustee Henry

- Mindy Atwood has resigned as Library Director effective June 7th she has worked for Salisbury for seven years. Tuesday, June 7th there will be an open house at the Salisbury Free Library from 5 7 pm to say goodbye to Mindy. Refreshments will be served.
- Position was posted and they got four responses. All four individuals were interviewed and they selected Katherine Bollenbach of Loudon who accepted the position. She will begin June 9th.
- Library is down an aid. This positon will be posted by the new Director.
- Henry noted the library is in good shape budget wise for salaries for the upcoming year.
- Selectman Ross-Raymond reported that he checked the basement of the Library today and is happy to report that the dehumidifiers are working and all is dry.

It was also brought up by Selectmen that if citizens bring garbage, debris that they indicated they picked up on side of road, trails, etc. that they should not be charged and Board would like to be made aware when this happens and get the names of people for thank you purposes.
- Transfer Station Additional Hours will begin next Wednesday June 8th from 2 6 PM. This will be in effect for three months and reviewed in September to determine next step.
