Chairman Ross-Raymond called meeting to order at 5:30 PM.

Rick and Melvin had general question regarding sexton compensation for stipend and fees paid by individual purchasing lots to have cornerstones set and why taxes are assessed. Selectmen explained he is an employee and taxes must come out of wages.

Visitors: Chairman Ross-Raymond welcomed Rep. David Karrick and candidate Mary Anne Broshek who stopped by to get a feel of what Salisbury residents have for issues of interest / concern for State Legislators. General discussion on school funding, taxes, revenue sources, roads etc. They asked if there were any specific issues town is looking for from the legislature. Selectmen indicated they would like our district representatives to continue being a voice for the people – to help with the financial burdens being passed down to the towns.

- TA Warren met with All Water works out of Franklin re: water filtration system at Safety Bldg. It could be covered by a grant where town pays upfront and gets reimbursed for half. Need to get the water tested and then company will give a quote. Selectmen asked TA Warren to have a plumber look at the piping before moving forward.
- The elevator at AH was evaluated and measurements taken to see if it might be able to be replaced with one bigger and hydraulic. Present lift is obsolete. Also some problem with a conduit in wrong place and light bulb should have a cage or be rough use resistant. Waiting for quote on replacement of elevator and in the meantime Selectman Ross-Raymond will get rough resistant bulb.

New Business:

- Town Offices closed Thursday November 24th Thanksgiving
- Bldg Inspector reviewed cracks in wall at Library and left his report for Selectmen to follow up with Scott Bickford.
- Salisbury Elementary principal and MCSD notified TA Warren that Webster no longer wants to share DARE graduation. Salisbury will host own which is December 20th at 2 PM at Salisbury Elementary school.
- Cross Country contract DRA and Town Counsel reviewed and required some changes revised and ready for review and sign.
- TA Warren, TC Landry and AA Downes saw a demo for a website by Virtual Town Halls & Schools. This company has provided websites for many NH towns and is top notch. Cost is \$4,500 for set up and \$1,500 yearly for maintenance, licensing, security and support. TA Warren will also set up demos from other companies.
- TA Warren noted there is an open house on Thursday, Nov 3^{rd} at 5-7 PM for the new Webster Police Chief.
- April Rollins is signed up for grant writing course in Claremont, requested by Fire Department.
