

Salisbury Conservation Commission Meeting Summary May 31, 2022

Chairman Dave Kelly called the meeting to order at 6:10 p.m.

<u>Previous Meeting Minutes</u> - Members reviewed the April 27, 2022 meeting minutes. Member Bill MacDuffie motioned to accept the meeting minutes with small changes. Chairman Dave Kelly seconded that motion. All voted in favor. Motion carried.

<u>Old Business</u> - The Conservation Commission has decided that they will not write a letter of agreement for Joe Schmidl and Cindy Romano and their disapproval of any status change to the Old Center Rangeway abutting their properties due to incomplete information regarding this request. Salisbury Selectmen are in the process of discussing this case.

VRAP has still not started. As far as we know, we have not received the equipment to begin. Chairman Dave Kelly said he check with the NHDES to find out when we should start and when we will get the equipment.

<u>New Business</u> - Chairman Dave Kelly will check with Town Administrator April Rollins to find out how many seats we should have on the Conservation Commission. Member Bill MacDuffie stated that Sarah John, who has shown interest in joining the Conservation Commission and was nominated to the Salisbury Conservation Commission at the April 27, 2022 Conservation Commission meeting pending Selectmen's approval, will be discussed at the next Selectman's meeting and hopefully will be appointed to the Commission.
