

Salisbury Conservation Commission Meeting Summary April 27, 2022

Chairman Dave Kelly called the meeting to order at 7:05 p.m.

<u>Previous Meeting Minutes</u> - Members reviewed the January 26, 2022 meeting minutes. <u>Member Bill MacDuffie motioned to accept the meeting minutes</u>. <u>Chairman Dave Kelly seconded that motion</u>. <u>All voted in favor</u>. <u>Motion carried</u>. Members reviewed the February 23, 2022 meeting minutes. <u>Member Kathleen Doyle motioned to accept the meeting minutes</u>. <u>Member Bill MacDuffie seconded that motion</u>. <u>All voted in favor</u>. <u>Motion carried</u>.

<u>Old Business</u> - VRAP is scheduled to begin May 8th pending our receipt of the equipment. Chairman Dave Kelly said he would stop by the NHDES lab to check on it. Member Laura Deming agreed to work out a schedule. Member Kathleen Doyle can pick up the equipment when available and will bring completed sheets to NHDES.

New Business - Joe Schmidl and Cindy Romano approached the Salisbury Conservation Commission to ask for a letter of agreement that the current road, Old Center Rangeway which passes between their properties, should not be returned to Class VI status. Joe Schmidl showed maps indicating the properties that are accessed along this road are highly ranked as important conservation properties. Member Kathleen Doyle mentioned that she read on the Salisbury Facebook page that someone was harassing Salisbury citizens who wanted to walk down or travel this road. Cindy Romano said they have never harassed or stopped anyone from using this road, though they did place a sign which says private access only. Member Kathleen Doyle thought that perhaps we should hear from the Roses, who submitted the petition to reclassify and are owners of multiple parcels located along the Old Center Rangeway, as to why this is being submitted.

On April 12, 2022, Leon Riel announced his resignation from the Salisbury Conservation Commission at the Town Office in Academy Hall. Additionally, Alternate Member Peg Boyles announced her resignation as an alternate member via email on April 12, 2022. Peg stated she would like to continue as a volunteer for the VRAP program and may rejoin the Conservation Commission again at a later date. The Salisbury Conservation Commission would like to thank these past members for their time and service to the Commission and to their Town.

Sarah John informed the Conservation Commission she was interested in joining as a full member. Member Kathleen Doyle made a motion to nominate Sarah John to the Salisbury Conservation Commission. Secretary Cheryl Bentley seconded that motion. All voted in favor.
