Member Bill MacDuffie advised members that the property behind the ballfield will most likely not be selected as the new Salisbury Department of Public Works site. However, members might want to consider it for conservation purposes. The site is approximately 10 acres. Members discussed rules associated with the Conservation Commission's ability to purchase land. Members need to pull the original warrant article related to conservation for review. Member Kathleen Doyle indicated that she would research that information.

Member Sarah MacDuffie will prepare the Conservation Commission's 2023 Annual Report which is thought to be due sometime in October.

A thank you card was received from the Webster Elementary Camp for the conservation presentation provided by Dave Kelly.
