<u>Review & Approve Minutes of February 8, 2018</u> – Selectman Ross-Raymond made a **motion** to approve the meeting minutes of February 8, 2018 without correction. Dave Merwin **seconded** the motion and the **motion passed unanimously**.

<u>Election of Officers</u> - Selectman Ross-Raymond made a **motion** to nominate Marcia Murphy as Chairman and Dave Merwin as Vice Chairman of the Budget Committee. Sal Morgani **seconded** the motion and the **motion passed unanimously**.

Recommendations for the 2019 Budget - Chair Murphy asked the members of the Budget Committee if there was anything they may want to look at or discuss from last year. Jason Hood replied employee compensation was left incomplete, so it should be revisited. Selectman Ross-Raymond stated he has recommendations for the Town's employee salaries. Dave Merwin asked if the increases were based on a performance evaluation and given based on merit. Selectman Ross-Raymond replied we can have that discussion. Sal Morgani stated he would like to have the outside organizations the Town funds come to a meeting and show us their books because the statistics presented didn't mean that much to him, we have no way of knowing if the services are being subsidized or not. Selectman Ross-Raymond replied he would be in favor of that and there is no reason we cannot invite them to a meeting. Dave Kelly stated there have been a lot of recent breakins throughout Town and we should have a discussion regarding expanding the State Police coverage or going the other route.

<u>Selectmen's Report</u> - Selectman Ross-Raymond reported people have made it clear they want the mistake made by DRA, in regards to the tax rate, fixed and the Selectmen will hear back from DRA regarding a potential correction in June. Selectman Ross-Raymond stated he has spoken with Superintendent MacLean and the Town's obligation to the School District should be less this coming year because enrollment is down by 14 students.
